

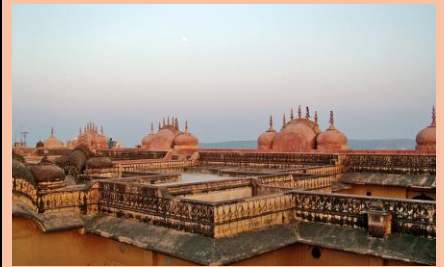
TOURIST PLACES IN JAIPUR:



- ❖ [Amber Fort Palace](#) is located amidst the picturesque and rocky Aravalli Hills. The foundation stone of this palace was laid by Raj Man Singh and was completed by Mirja Raj Jai Singh
- ❖ **Visiting Hours:**
 - 8:00 A.M. to 5:30 P.M.
- ❖ **Entry fees:**
 - For Indians: 10 RS
 - For Foreign Nationals: 50 RS



- ❖ [Hawa Mahal](#) or the Palace of Winds, built by Maharaja Pratap Sinigh, is located on the southern part of Jaipur
- ❖ **Visiting Hours:**
 - 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
- ❖ **Entry fees:**
 - For Indians: 10 RS
 - For Foreign Nationals: 50 RS



- ❖ [Nahargarh Fort](#) is standing on the edge of the hills of Aravalli, it gives a mesmerizing view of the pink city of Jaipur.
- ❖ **Visiting Hours:**
 - 9:30 A.M. to 5:30 P.M.
- ❖ **Entry fees:**
 - For Indians: 10 RS
 - For Foreign Nationals: 50 RS



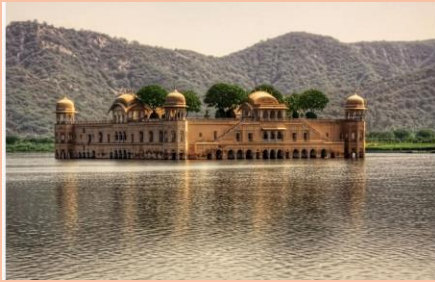
- ❖ [Birla Mandir](#), also known as the Lakshmi Narayan Temple. It is located at the base of the Moti Dungari Hill in Jaipur with lord Vishnu and goddess Lakshmi as the main deities
- ❖ **Visiting Hours:**
 - 8.00 AM to 12.00 Noon;
 - 4.00 PM to 8.00 PM Every day.
- ❖ **Photography:** Not allowed



- ❖ [Jantar Mantar](#) built by Maharaja Jai Singh, this observatory, officially declared as the national monument, has a huge collection of astronomical instruments
- ❖ **Visiting Hours:**
 - 9:30 A.M. to 4:30 P.M.
- ❖ **Photography :** Not allowed



- ❖ [City Palace](#) is located in the heart of Jaipur, it is the most remarkable monument in the list of places to visit in Jaipur guarded by huge imposing walls
- ❖ **Visiting Hours:**
 - 9:30 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.
- ❖ **Entry Fees:**
 - For Indians : 40 RS
 - For Foreigners : 200 RS



- ❖ [Jal Mahal](#) is located in the middle of Man Sagar lake, this place is also a fusion of Mughal and Rajput styles of architecture. Built in red sandstone, it is a five storey building, of which four storeys remain underwater when the lake is filled
- ❖ **Visiting Hours:**
 - 6:00 A.M. - 6:00 P.M.
- ❖ **Photography Allowed :** Yes



- ❖ [Albert Hall](#) is one of the oldest museums in Jaipur as well as in India, and was built by Sir Samuel Jacob in the 19th Century. It is known as the states museum for Rajasthan
- ❖ **Visiting Hours:**
 - 9:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.
- ❖ **Entry fees:**
 - For Indians: 20 RS
 - For Foreigners : 150 RS



- ❖ [Jaigarh Fort](#), Built in the 18th century by Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh II as a shield to protect Amber Fort and Jaipur city from attack of invaders
- ❖ **Visiting Hours:**
 - 10.00 AM to 6.00 PM Every day.
- ❖ **Photography:** Allowed



- ❖ [Galtaji](#) is an ancient pilgrimage centre in Jaipur. The green landscape and chattering monkeys add to the delight of the area. Constructed by Diwan Kriparam, the temple can be seen from anywhere in the city. Built by Maharaja Jai Singh, this observatory, officially declared as the national monument
- ❖ **Visiting Hours:**
 - 9:30 A.M. to 4:30 P.M.
- ❖ **Photography :** Not allowed



- ❖ [Nahargarh Biological Garden](#) it encompasses a large area of 720 hectares and is situated under the Aravalli range. The Park is famous for its vast flora and fauna, and its main aim is to conserve it.
- ❖ **Visiting Hours:**
 - 8:30 A.M. to 5:30 P.M.
- ❖ **Entry Fees:**
 - For Indians : 30 RS
 - For Foreigners : 200 RS



- ❖ [Bhangarh](#), holds the distinction of being one of the most haunted places in India
- ❖ **Visiting Hours:**
 - 6.00 AM to 6.00 PM Every day.
- ❖ **Photography:** Allowed



- ❖ [Kanak Vrindavan](#), is scenic garden which is parted into eight sections. It is popular spot for picnic and film shoots
- ❖ **Visiting Hours:**
 - 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.
- ❖ **Photography :** Allowed



- ❖ [Moti Doongri](#) temple of Lord Ganesha is famous for its divine powers
- ❖ **Visiting Hours:**
 - 5:30 A.M. to 1:30 P.M.
 - 4:30 P.M. to 9:00 P.M.
